

On Tuesday, December 10, 2024, Mayor Dave Johannes called to order the Stockton City Council meeting at Stockton City Hall at 6:00 PM. The council members in attendance were Lisa Gibbs, Brian Koetz, and Carissa Blagborne. Mark Potter was not in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Public Voice Forum : none

Dave Johannes made a motion to accept the agenda; the motion was seconded by Carissa Blagborne. Motion passed.

Carissa Blagborne made a motion to accept the financial report and to pay all the bills. Motion seconded by Lisa Gibbs; motion passed.

Brian Koetz made a motion to accept November 12, 2024, public hearing and council minutes; seconded by Carissa Blagborne. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Election Canvass: Mark Potter stated he would accept the write-in votes for a council member position.

2025 Budget Levy: Dave Johannes made a motion to set the budget at \$125,000. Motion seconded by Carissa Blagborne; motion passed unanimously.

CITY MAINTENANCE

New Truck: Lewiston Auto has a Chevy Silverado at \$48,885 but has a 3-5 month lead time. Chrysler of Winona had a Ford 350 for \$51,226 and a Dodge Ram for \$54,015. Dave Johannes made a motion to purchase the Chevy Silverado from Lewiston Auto; motion seconded by Brian Koetz. Motion passed unanimously.

- The dump truck is not running at the time as there are problems with the electrics and injectors. Chad will need to get a second opinion as the first quote from Jim Peterson Trucking would cost between \$5,000 and \$10,000. Discussed different companies he could call to request a quote from.
- Chad will be on vacation for 2 weeks beginning January 2. He will also be on vacation for the first 2 weeks in February

Meyers complaint: Looks like he has started to make an effort to clean and will have until December 14, 2024, to come into compliance. If the council is not happy with the effort, then the city can abate the nuisance. Discussion on companies that may contract out to clean the property.

Lisa Gibbs made a motion to close the Stockton City Council meeting, with a second from Carissa Blagborne. The motion passed unanimously; the meeting adjourned at 6:25 PM.
