

Ordinance #27

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMBINATION  
OF THE OFFICES OF CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER  
AND PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL CITY AUDITS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF STOCKTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Laws 1961, the office of clerk and treasurer in the City of Stockton, Winona County, Minnesota, are hereby combined in the office of clerk-treasurer.

Section 2. Beginning with the year in which this ordinance becomes effective, and each year thereafter, there shall be an audit of the city's financial affairs by the State Auditor or a Public Accountant in accordance with minimum auditing procedures prescribed by the State Auditor.

Section 3. This ordinance is effective after its passage and publication.
